

The JW Marriott Houston recently completed a \$12 million renovation of all guestrooms, suites, guest floor corridors, elevators and health club. Now offering 514 guestrooms and 28 suites, each guest room now features the new JW Marriott Revive Bedding, entirely new furnishings and soft goods, and the areas only 32” flat panel LCD TV’s. The guest rooms are also equipped with comfortable and ergonomic work chairs, ethernet connectivity for high-speed internet access, and are equipped to handle multiple video and audio connections from personal devices. The complete re-invention of the Concierge lounge is expected to be complete by the end of 2006.

The fitness center has undergone a complete renovation with all new professional level equipment including cardio theatre for each bike, treadmill, stair stepper etc. The dry sauna, steam room and pool areas have also received a facelift to a resort quality.

The hotel is poised to begin the second phase of the renovation plan which will total over \$8 million. This will include a total transformation of the 13,000 square foot Exhibit Hall which will be renamed the Liberty Ballroom, a key component of the 40,000 square feet of meeting space.

The lobby bar will embrace a new stylish concept that will be unveiled towards the end of 2007 along with the addition of a fully licensed Starbucks outlet by June 2007. To complement the new lobby bar and Starbucks, the entire lobby will be transformed into a “Great Room” concept which will be even more conducive to do business, work on the laptop, or just gather for socializing before an event.
