Project

Individuals turned to judicial and legal routes in an attempt to stop the implementation of the Post Oak Boulevard Project.

First, they filed a lawsuit against METRO in Harris County District Court. That case was dismissed by the court. *See, Cosmopolitan Condominium Owners Ass'n v. Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County (270<sup>th</sup> Dist. Ct., Harris Cty., Tex. June 15, 2015).*

Second, they turned to the Attorney General of Texas, asking the same question. Monday, the Attorney General issued his Opinion in which he did not answer the question, but stated the "issues are beyond the purview of an attorney general opinion." The Attorney General also stated "Your question is the same question that was before a court [*referenced above*]. This cause has been dismissed and is no longer in litigation."
